We welcome all validly received (baptized) Catholics to receive God's Blessings and his Holy Presence in the Holy Catholic Sacrament's under our religious jurisdiction..

In order to cover reasonable expenses incurred by these religious authorities on behalf of the persons requesting the Sacraments under the ecclesiastical jurisdiction of the aforesaid religious bodies of Christ, the following is a donation schedule and petitioner request: Your kind support of our charities will be acknowledged by a special Blessing and Nuptial Mass said especially for you. Rest assured you will be received with the honour and dignity you deserve by our Ordre.

As a petitioner for an ecclesiastical concernment, I agree to the following IRS approved tax deductible, nonrefundable, noncancelable, stole donation which should be enclosed with the attached application bearing our signature(s).

- I. **Sacrament of Marriage** a single donation shall be \$600.00. Through which a couple receives special graces to live together as husband and wife and through which this union is blessed. A Certificate of Marriage will be given to the couple attesting to the reception of the Sacrament and a Marital Mass Certificate indicating God's blessings.
- II. **Dispensations** may be afforded the petitioner(s) under special circumstances upon recommendation by an authorized Priest of Chevaliers de Notre Dame. Single dispensations require a \$300.00 additional donation.
- III **Baptism of both children and adults** through which one receives spiritual life and becomes a member of the living Body of Christ, the Church. The customary donation is \$300.00. The application for the Sacrament may be downloaded from the website.
- IV. **Nuptial Mass/Chapel:** The Internal Revenue Service requires a separate contribution to cover these stole donations. Therefore, the required nominal donation for the sacramental mass/chapel mileage donation is payable on the day of the reception of the Holy Sacrament . You will receive an approved receipt acknowledging your tax deductible contribution to our charities.
- V. **SACRAMENTAL GUARANTEE:** Ecclesia Dei Pontifical Commission of the Roman Catholic Church vouchsafes the validity of our Holy Sacraments and Holy Orders; thereby assuring you of a Valid Catholic Sacrament. We secure this approbation with a **\$250,000.00** Sacramental guarantee. [Prot #236/98]
- VI **Donations to Charities** are stringently controlled by State and Federal regulations. All donations, enabling media documentation and impediment removal for the Catholic Sacraments MUST be completed and received 30 days prior to receiving the Sacrament. This enables us to complete the registration requirements. Should fees or disbursements be required to complete this agreement, the petitioner agrees to reimburse this Religious Ordre for all reasonable expenditures.
